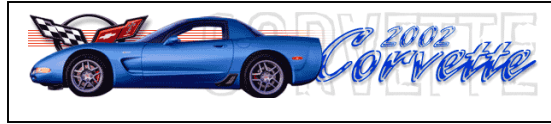

**General Membership Meeting Minutes
February 8, 2011**

President: Larry Yon called the meeting to order at 7:35pm. After welcoming everyone Larry informed the group that the club had suffered a couple losses in the past week. Member Don Stephens lost his father and past president, Tom Wilcox suffered the passing of his daughter. Sympathy cards have been mailed with our condolences.

Larry gave a quick run-down of the US Play event with Calvary Children's home. He stated 19 club members and over 30 children from Calvary's had a very enjoyable time.

Larry says that he is looking forward to the Valentine's trip to the Biltmore House. In addition he stated we had received a thank you card from the Foster Care Association we assisted during the holidays. The note stated they would definitely be able to put the sneakers to good use. Larry also cautioned the group because we have received an inordinate amount of parade request. He doesn't want us to get overloaded with parades and get "paraded out."

Secretary's report: Keelie Sparks stated the minutes from the last meeting had been published in the newsletter.
