Kick-off of the Parade is scheduled for 12:30 pm and over approximately by 2:00pm, but your unit will be allowed to enter the formation areas at 10:30 am on Tuesday, December 31, 2013. It may be necessary to add units after the publication of this parade order. If a new unit has been placed in front of you, you will be notified by a Parade Marshal. Arrival of your unit should be no later than 11:30am. (Official Parade Marshals will be wearing black Chick-fil-A Bowl fleeces and nametags).

Start Time: Staging area opens at 10:30 am; Tuesday, December 31, 2013.

- Parade will step off at 12:30 pm

<u>Parade Route:</u> Beginning at the intersection of Ralph McGill Blvd. and Peachtree Street; south down Peachtree Street turning right (west) onto Andrew Young International Blvd. through Centennial Olympic Park; finish at Georgia World Congress Center – Upper International Plaza (Between Georgia Dome and Philips Arena)
