HISTORY OF THE PARADE

The Old Soldiers Day Parade began years ago as a tribute to veterans of the "war between the states", but was discontinued after a few years. Twenty eight years later, in 1952, a small group of men in Alpharetta re-dedicated Old Soldiers Day Parade in Alpharetta and started having a parade through downtown Alpharetta. Thanks to these few men and their belief in keeping this memorable tradition alive, this parade has become an annual celebration to all veterans of all wars.; this year marking 65 years.

Along with the program and parade, this celebration will also feature floats, bands, entertainment, children's activities, and prizes. Free hot dogs and soft drinks will be available at the American Legion at 201 Wills Road at the end of the parade. With so much to celebrate, take this day to recognize the living memory of all veterans of war.
