Dear Parade Participant,

The Fourth in the Park Festival is almost here. Enclosed please find a parade line-up map, flyer and rules. Share this information with all participants. We are excited about the day's activities, and are especially excited that you have chosen to spend the day in Marietta. Remember all activities take place on **Monday**, **July 4th**.

- Review the enclosed map. Please enter the staging area according to the map.
- Post the enclosed entry number in your front window-top/passenger side. If walking, just have it on hand for staging purposes.
- Arrive on time! Enter via Roswell Rd. unless otherwise requested. Remember there are 2,000 people and 100 entries in the staging area that could also be lost. All vehicles must be in place at the assigned time, however, participants may arrive as late at 9:30 a.m.
- ABSOLUTELY no throwing of candy or other materials during the parade-this is a safety issue and will be strictly enforced. Hand held signs are also prohibited.
- Remember it will be hot. Bring water bottles for all participants.
- The parade takes place rain or shine and begins at 10:00 a.m. Forward movement is required of all entries during the parade. Two car lengths or roughly 20 feet must be maintained between each entry.
- Parade entries will be announced on East Park Square. Stopping is NOT permitted. Just wave, smile and keep going!!!
- Parade Marshals will be wearing "Fourth in the Park" T-shirts if you need assistance. Please work with their requests.
- PARKING is NOT available at the end of the parade (Cherokee St. and N. Marietta Parkway)! CCT is providing shuttle service (air conditioned) back to Roswell Street Baptist Church and the Center for Family Resources (old Life University) lot. Plan to meet your party there. Talk about your meeting place before parade day!!!
- All floats entries participating in the float contest MUST be in position by 8:00 a.m. Judging begins at 8:15 a.m. with last viewing by judges at 9:15 a.m. Enter the church lot using the entrance just west of the church. (see map)
