

Visit the Delta Museum & Flight Facilities



When: Saturday, October 14, 2017

Where: We will meet in the parking lot of "The 120 Tavern" 1440 Roswell Rd., Marietta

> Time: Gather at 9:00 AM with a PROMPT 9:15 AM departure

Delta Air Lines is happy to welcome you to the <u>Delta Heritage Museum</u> on October 14, 2017. I propose a slight change to the arrival time at Sidelines Tavern. The Museum doesn't open until 10:00AM so if we leave as early as originally planned, we'll get there way early. Also, the 747 exhibit doesn't open until 12:00. I think you will enjoy as much time as possible in the museum and then see the 747. I haven't seen it but since I've ridden on her, I'm eager to see how they present the Queen of the skies.

I suggest that we meet at around 9:00AM with a departure time around 9:15 AM or so. It will take 30 minutes, usually, to get to the airport. We will travel down I-75 to I-85S and exit on Loop Road. You can't miss it because you can see the 747, 757 and DC-9 in the parking lot! We will turn into the gate for the museum. A security guard will stop us and open the gate to the museum parking.

We will tour the museum for as long as you want. I do want to see the 747, though! When you get to the Chairman's Club exhibit, you can look for my ugly mug in 2004.

We will be able to handle a few last minute changes but I have to pre-authorize anyone coming on the property. Children ARE welcome and photography is permitted in most areas. Wear comfortable shoes cause I'm gonna walk you to death! My plan is the OCC first due to time constraints. We will visit the "ditching pool," flight attendant training and might be

able to see the emergency slide system. We will visit the pilot training and the simulator section.
