For iPhone and Android users for C6 and prior Corvettes

1. On your iPhone or Android, open email with link and click on link for the route.
2. Google Maps will open with the route already laid out.
3. If you are starting at home, you can put in your home address as the starting point
4. You can start using Google Maps on the cell phone for directions of the route

For iPhone and Android users with C7 Corvettes

1. On your iPhone or Android, open email with link and click on link for the route.
2. Google Maps will open with the route already laid out.
3. If you are starting at home, you can put in your home address as the starting point
4. Before connecting your iPhone/Android to the USB port, start the car first
5. Once the car is started, connect the cell phone to the USB port. Google Maps will not work with Bluetooth
6. Click on the Apple Car Play or Android Auto icon to access Google Maps
7. Click on the Google Maps icon.
8. Once in Google Maps, you should be able to see your route displayed in the head unit in Google Maps and also on your cell phone simultaneously

Please note that this process does not work with the GM or Apple Maps navigation system.

via I-575 N and GA-515 E/State Rte 515
5 h 53 min without traffic

QuikTrip, 9765 GA-92, Woodstock, GA 30188
Turn right onto the Interstate 575 N/GA-5 ramp 0.4 mi
Merge onto GA-5 N/I-575 N 23.3 mi
Continue onto GA-515 E/State Rte 515 41.6 mi
Turn left onto Josh Hall Rd 338 ft
1 h 8 min (65.8 mi)

RaceWay, 4581 Appalachian Hwy, Blue Ridge, GA 30513
Head south on Josh Hall Rd toward US-76 30 ft
Turn right onto US-76 W 0.4 mi
Turn right onto GA-5 N/Blue Ridge Dr
Pass by Dairy Queen Grill & Chill (on the left in 0.2 mi)
Entering Tennessee 10.2 mi
Turn left onto TN-68 N 36.5 mi
Turn right onto Cherohala Skyway/Unicoi Turnpike 108 ft
Turn left onto Bank St
Destination will be on the right 0.2 mi
1 h 8 min (47.3 mi)

Tellicafe, 128 Bank St, Tellico Plains, TN 37385
Head south on Bank St toward Cherohala Skyway/Unicoi Turnpike 0.2 mi
Turn left onto Cherohala Skyway/Unicoi Turnpike
Continue to follow Cherohala Skyway
Entering North Carolina 48.4 mi
Continue straight onto Snowbird Rd 2.6 mi
Turn right onto Junaluska Rd 0.3 mi
Turn left onto S Main St 0.1 mi
Turn left onto Snider Hill 95 ft
1 h 17 min (51.6 mi)

Robbinsville, North Carolina 28771
Take S Main St to US-129 S/Rodney Orr Bypass 2 min (0.6 mi)
Take US-74 W to NC-60 S in Notla 49 min (41.7 mi)
Continue on NC-60 S. Take GA-60Spur to GA-515 W/US-76 W in Fannin

County 17 min (14.4 mi)
Follow GA-515 W and I-575 S to GA-92 N/Alabama Rd NE in Woodstock. Take
exit 7 from I-575 S 1 h 10 min (68.9 mi)
Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto GA-92 N/Alabama Rd NE 1 min (0.5 mi)
2 h 20 min (126 mi)
