THE NCM OPENS JUNE 8TH!

Tomorrow, May 20, 2020 is the last day to register for the “Virtual Bash” to be held on May 28-29 - no later than 5:00 pm Central Daylight Time). Bowling Green is one hour behind us.

Once the agenda is confirmed with the speakers for the Virtual Bash, those registered will be emailed with the schedule. Katie Ellison is hoping this will be done by Friday or early next week.

Cost of Virtual Bash only, not receiving credentials, pins, or dash plaque is \$20.
