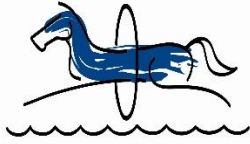

We have planned a visit to the Farm for a special club event day that focuses on their Horses Helping Heroes program for Veterans. We also are getting to see first-hand the facility and meet some of the staff. You will be moved by the special care that is provided to the disabled.

- The morning will begin with a tour of the farm (Wear comfortable shoes!), followed by demonstrations with the therapy horses.
- Veterans will have the opportunity to visit **CGCC Corvette Car Corral** to see all our Corvettes.
- A light lunch from Chick-fil-A will be held at the facility, attended by McKenna staff, volunteers, and Veterans with our Club members.
- All COVID-19 precautions in effect at the time will be observed.

### About McKenna Farms

McKenna provides therapy services to children and individuals with special needs. They offer physical, occupational, and speech therapies in various settings including clinical, aquatic, and with the use of horses for hippotherapy. They also offer summer camps, free parent support groups and workshops, and a Therapeutic Riding program that includes a Special Olympics Equestrian Team and services for veterans. The Farm hosts community events throughout the year including a Derby Day fundraiser in May, Fall Festival in October, and a special visit with Santa for families in December.

Plan to arrive in your Corvette to park in the paved parking area up behind the main office and in front of the barn between 10:30 and 11:00 am. Location 3044 Due West Rd., Dallas, Ga. The event is outdoors, bring and wear masks, social distancing is recommended. Please bring some folding chairs to sit by your cars.

You'll be visiting McKenna Farm with 75 or more Veterans from 11:00am-2:00pm. The first 60 minutes you can observe the presentation of programs available to the Veterans, tour the farm and see riding demonstrations. From 12:30 to 1:30 will be free time for the veterans to check out your cars and to have lunch together outdoors.

Here are some general guidelines for talking with the veterans:

These talking points are not specific to our veterans, they are a blanket set of guidelines that would apply to any post war vet who may suffer from any combat related issue, whether physical or emotional.

#### **Some Don'ts**

- Please don't ask the veteran "What's wrong with you?" or "How did you get injured?"
- Please don't ask if they saw action, lost anyone or if they ever killed anyone.
- Please don't force any conversation if it's not well received. If the veteran is reclusive, respect that please and politely excuse yourself with no judgement.
- No Loud Engine Revving noises, for the Horses and the Veterans protection.

#### **Some Do's**

- Invite them to check out your car. Talking about your car will be a great Ice-breaker.
- You may talk about your own military service, if the veteran seems receptive. Just be aware that some of them have complicated feelings about their own service, and it may be a sensitive topic.
- How our club helps support the Farm and what the club does for them.
