What we mean by "Modified" for SuperVette Saturday

- The term 'modified car' denotes a car that has been significantly altered for the purpose of increased engine and/or handling performance, appearance, comfort or convenience.
- Engine modifications can include but are not limited to: non stock OEM, tunnel rams, superchargers, turbo chargers and/or late model tuned port-type fuel injection on an earlier era car.
- Body and/or chassis work that involves redesign of the original stock body lines, ride height, including but not limited to nosing, chopping, channeling, sectioning, changing radius of wheel wells, molding, tunneling, etc.
- Also significant custom paint or paint work that is of custom design such as painted graphics, shading, blending, candy, pearl, neon, or murals.
- Interiors that are of a custom design that consist of changes from stock to three or more of the following: seats, door panels, dash modifications, carpeting, flooring, headliner and/or cargo/trunk area.
